Over time the chair has had finishes ranging from plastic to fiberglass and then 100% recyclable polypropylene, a more sustainable solution. Today, the design takes its next step forward with the launch of the Eames Moulded Wood Chair. Today's 3-D veneer technology allows the wood veneer to be moulded into the complex curves of a single shell, with a level of flexibility that would previously have been unattainable. The result is an authentic form that honours the same organic shapes and sleek lines of their classic work. The Moulded Wood Chair also celebrates Charles and Ray's appreciation of honest materials.

The Eames Moulded Wood chair is available in White Ash, Santos Palisander, and Walnut with different bases and base finishes.
